Synopsis Regular Board Meeting Minutes
November 9, 2004

Supervisor Little called the regular board meeting to order at 8:00 p.m. Board members Little, Alexa, Haeussler, Weidmayer and Horning were all present. October Minutes and Treasurers report were approved.

Audience Participation: Resident expressed her disappointment in the circulation of a letter several days prior to the election opposing the purchase of the Pleasant Lake School and wanting to withdraw from the Manchester District Library. The biggest concern was; will any action be taken for the chairperson of a township committee. Another resident ask for the total of the presidential election for Freedom Township. Dave Davis went to the road commission meeting. To ask again for them to look into changing the passing lines on Pleasant Lake from the Pleasant Lake bar to the pumping station to solid yellow lines, they are having a representative meet with him.

History Report- The Cemetery at Hieber and Schneider road, there has been white steel crosses put at each burial site. In addition, a complete list of everyone who has been buried is on record. The Buss family history in Freedom Township has been completed.

Ordinance Officer Report: - Violation notice was given to the resident on Bemis rd., regarding the hauling of materials. He may not haul until the board sees receipts from last year and this year.

Zoning Inspector report: – Zoning permit for a house and garage.

District Library: – Since the election mileage passed, they are working on long-range planning and goal setting. Newsletter has been sent out to all residents.

Clerk's report: - recycle bin has been moved to the lower part of the town hall parking lot. The election went smoothly. Message board has been delivered.

Fire Report: - there was three fire runs in October, for a total of 39 for the year.

Business: Resolution was passed to help Levy receive a grant to help pay for the intersection at Pleasant Lake and Ann Arbor Saline rd. The resolution was needed because the gravel company is based in Freedom Township. There will be no cost to the township. Levy reported that the monitoring well is in place and the staked survey for the ARS parcel is done. Warrants were approved. The meeting was adjourned at 8:50 p.m.
