Synopsis Regular Board Meeting Minutes
June 14, 2005

Supervisor Little called the regular board meeting to order at 8:00 p.m. Board members Little, Alexa, Haeussler, Weidmayer were present. Horning was absent. The May 10, 2005 regular board minutes & treasurers report were approved.

Public Participation – Township is considering a bid to put a slab of cement for the recycle bins so they are off the parking area. The treasurer informed us that on the summer tax bill will have a third of the county taxes on it and two-thirds on the winter tax bill.

Ordinance Officer Report: - The van on Pleasant Lake rd has been taken care of. The pleasant lake bar has been within the noise ordinance level. Two vehicles on Elmdale have been turned over to the township attorneys.

Zoning Inspector report: – Stop order was given to Panhandle, the situation has been handled panhandle needs to supply the PC with a new site plan.

District Library: – The library budget was approved. Jane Thornton is the new Freedom township Library board member and Lois Pawlusiak for Bridgewater. There is wireless internet for the public to use. Summer reading programs for children and adults.

Clerk's report: - Landscaping for the town hall has been completed. There is a new phone with an answering machine in the town hall office.

Business: Washtenaw County road commission contract was approved. Steinbach, Bethel church intersection project has been started. Road patrol and jail discussions are continuing. Wireless Washtenaw resolution of support was approved. By the end of November 2005 there will be a pilot for wireless Washtenaw. S.W. council would like to be the host. There is great representation by the townships supporting this. Manchester Chicken broil has its own website. Western Washtenaw Construction Authority fee Schedule was approved with a fee price increases. Township Board has approved the planning commission to go ahead with the amendments to the master plan to pursue qualifying for the PDR program. Maintenance breakage deposit for the town hall rental has been changed to \$125.00. The town hall will purchase a new pressure tank for the water softener. Motion passed unanimously. Warrants were approved. The meeting was adjourned at 9:00 p.m.
