Synopsis Regular Board Meeting Minutes
March 8, 2005

Supervisor Little called the regular board meeting to order at 8:00 p.m. Board members Little, Alexa, Haeussler, Weidmayer was present, Horning was absent. Regular board minutes, & Treasurers report were approved.

Audience Participation: A resident read an article from the newspaper against being charged the administrative fee that cities and townships charge.

Planning Commission: - Land Division on parker road was approved, another land split was tabled, until there is further information. The planner was asked to show the PC invoices before they are paid. The county will attend the next PC meeting to discuss the Brauer property that the county purchased. March 29th there will be a working session with American aggregates and Waterland trucking.

Ordinance Officer Report: - Vehicle was reported on Elmdale with no plates, a warning was issued to remove the vehicle. The decibel meter reading at the Pleasant lake bar was between 53 and 57 decibels.

Zoning Inspector report: – One zoning permit was issued for a new house and garage. On Bemis rd.

District Library: – Surveys have been tabulated, 400 surveys were returned. There is a new story time for infants & toddlers. The LSTA grant is on schedule to put old microfilm online. National library week is April 11-15 evening events will be planned.

Clerk's report: -As of 1/1/05 county governments no longer have to reimburse townships for any elections. 49 Norvell residents who are in the Manchester school district will be able to vote in the May 3rd election at the Freedom township-polling place.

Business: 2005-2006 budget was approved. Township approved to change recycle companies to Modern Waste. Administration fee not to exceed 1% starting with the summer 2005 tax bill was approved. Resolution for a new optical scan machine at no charge from the State was passed. Waterland trucking variance request was tabled. Current budget was amended. Warrants were approved. The meeting was adjourned at 9:15 p.m.
