Synopsis Board Meeting Minutes
October 10, 2006

Supervisor Little called the regular board meeting to order at 8:00 p.m. Board members Little, Alexa, Haeussler, Horning and Weidmayer were present. September 12, 2006 regular board minutes, and treasurer's report were approved.

Planning Commission: The application for Washtenaw County Parks, the township attorney is writing the conditional use permit. Township attorney is proofing the final draft of the Extradition ordinance. The property on Scio Church is a home occupation. PC recommended a new engineering firm for the township, Orchard, Hiltz & McCliment, Inc. Motion passed to hire the new firm. The planner is bringing the zoning ordinance up to date. The Planning commission's next meeting will be November 9, 2006 due to the election. A letter by panhandle has been filed.

Zoning Inspector: One zoning permit, a deck on Bethel Church.

Ordinance Enforcement Officer: No new actions, still waiting for the truck at Pleasant Lake Inn to be removed.

Library report: Circulation increased 23% over last September. Cathy Harmon the youth services Librarian has resigned a replacement search has started. Demolition and masonry work is mostly completed. Pat Mann one of the townships district library delegates has resigned, anyone in Freedom township interested please contact one of the board members.

Clerk's report: November election has over 50 AV ballots so far, the new Auto mark has to be updated by the State before the election.

Business: Washtenaw county commissioners are looking for residents to seat on varies boards. A proposed House bill, if townships have their own police department that the monies would stay in the jurisdictions. PDR was tabled. Warrants were approved. The meeting was adjourned at 8:40 p.m.
