

**Freedom Township**  
**Regular Board Meeting Minutes**  
**June 12, 2007**

Supervisor Little called the regular board meeting to order at 8:03 p.m. Board members Little, Alexa, Haeussler, Horning & Weidmayer were present. Motion by Weidmayer seconded by Horning to approve the May 2, 2007 regular board minutes, motion carried by all ayes. Motion by Little seconded by Horning to approve the treasurer's report. Motion carried unanimously by roll call vote.

**Public Comment:** The CROW organization is going to have a garage sale July 13-14, 2007 to raise money for the Barrett Litigation. The Washtenaw County road commission is in process of brining the dirt roads.

**Planning Commission:** PC has changed there July meeting to the 2<sup>nd</sup> due to the fireworks. Private wastewater discussion. Discussed wireless Washtenaw. The resolution for the Brauer property is completed. Hubbell Roth and Clark files have been returned to the township. Discussion on water run offs on Hieber rd, due to storms, building or landscaping.

**Zoning Inspector:** Three zoning permits, issued one for a pool, sunroom and addition to a kitchen.

**Library Report:** The public hearing was held for the budget for next year. Renovations to start in August. Summer reading programs are ready to start.

**Clerks Report:** MTA is hosting a meeting in Ypsilanti June 25<sup>th</sup>, to oppose the bill HB 4780-88 that would give the county several duties that townships currently do. The township has expressed deep concern about this to our State Representative.

**Business:** Motion by Little to approve Glacier Creek Winery a license for a Micro Brewer and Small Wine Maker, seconded by Weidmayer, motion passed unanimously by a roll call vote. The board and audience discussed the Barrett Litigation bills, the township board has decided to wait till a meeting is held on June 26<sup>th</sup> with the MDEQ and all attorney's to see if the township will continue in the Litigation. Motion by Weidmayer, seconded by Little to sign the current Washtenaw County Road Commission contract for two brine applications this season. Motion by Little seconded by Horning to approve the new revision of the Extraction Ordinance, motion passed unanimously. Motion by Little seconded by Haeussler to approve the warrants, motion passed unanimously. The meeting was adjourned at 9:23 p.m.
