

Freedom Township
Synopsis Board Meeting Minutes
March 13, 2007

Regular board meeting/Budget Hearing was called to order at 8:03 p.m. Board members Little, Alexa, Haeussler, Horning & Weidmayer were present. 2007-2008 budget was presented. There was a discussion on the budget, took questions from the public. 2007-2008 budget was approved. February 13, 2007 regular board minutes with corrections, and treasurer's report were approved.

Public Comment: Bob Miller gave the township information on the history of Schneider and Reno road when they were paved, gravel companies were not allowed to use them to haul materials or travel on them with empty trucks. C & T has been using Schneider rd, residents have asked the township to bring the issue to the road commission, since Schneider rd is in bad shape. A resident ask the board to write a letter to DTE in regards to the disappointment in the response to the power outage on Saturday the 10th. A resident ask the board to approve Bob Hayes the township hydro geologist to finish his study on the Barret pit, motion passed.

Planning Commission: Resident on the lake would like the township to consider a sewer system for the lake residents, last time the issue was brought up, there was only a small majority of lake residents intereteded, there needs to be 51% of the lake residents wanting the sewer system before action can be taken. PC is working off a model of Lodi townships private waster water ordinance for Freedom Township. The PC will present the changes to the zoning ordinance to the township board in May.

Ordinance Enforcement officer: Checking on vehicles that have not been moved also a possible business being ran in the township.

Library report: Summer planning is on its way with different events. Remodeling project continues. Many people interested in the wireless Washtenaw forum going to take place March 26th at 7pm at the Manchester High School.

Clerks Report: Steelegrafix has given the township information on advertising in the Manchester magazine. April's township board meeting will be at 7pm to meet with the Washtenaw County road commission. The May township meeting will be May 2nd, due the election on the 8th. Information was shared to the residents on the amount of limestone the road commission is using on the roads in the township. A resident is interested in buying a plot in Freedom townships cemetery, more information is needed before that can take place.

Business: Motion passed to amend the current budget. Motion to approve warrants, passed. The meeting was adjourned at 9:27 p.m.
