Synopsis Board Meeting Minutes
November 14, 2006

Supervisor Little called the regular board meeting to order at 8:00 p.m. Board members Little, Alexa, Haeussler, and Weidmayer were present. Horning Absent. October 10, 2006 regular board minutes, and treasurer's report approved.

Planning Commission: The Washtenaw County Parks application, the parks changed the wording regarding the fencing around the property, property owners will be asked if they would like the fence or not. Extradition ordinance will go to the planner to review the final draft. Waterland Fisheries Incorporated is in the process of purchasing 120 acres on Bethel Church, the letter from the company has been forwarded to the Planner to get more information. The township board gave permission to the township attorney to sign the agreement for OHM Engineering firm.

Zoning Inspector: Two zoning permits, one new address and a pole barn at 4205 Schneider.

Ordinance Enforcement Officer: No new actions, the truck at Pleasant Lake Inn will be sold.

Library report: The elevator is in and waiting final inspection. Christmas in the village coloring contest begins Saturday the 18th. A new youth services librarian and assistant will be hired part-time. In addition, a part-time accounting/clerk will be hired.

Clerk's report: 69.08% of the township residents voted at the November election.

History report: Robert Miller worked with the Dettling family, to get the history on the family, at one time the family owned most of south Lima Center. Photos of the old Zion Lutheran Church are up at the town hall – the church is still used for weddings, renew of vows, to help maintain the church.

Business: The township board approved the amendment of the budget. The board approved Western Washtenaw Construction Authority to charge \$55 for low voltage wiring rough and final inspections. Warrants approved. The meeting was adjourned at 9:03 p.m.
