

**Freedom Township Planning Commission**  
April 7, 2015 Regular Meeting  
These minutes are not approved until our next meeting.

We began with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman Lindemann called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

Members present: Matt Little, Dan Schaible, Susan Ochs and Larry Lindemann. Members absent: Carol Huehl (excused). Planner Rodney Nanney and Supervisor Dale Weidmayer were also present, and Zoning Administrator Jim Coval arrived at 7:45 p.m. Chairman Lindemann noted that, in the absence of the Secretary, Planner Rodney Nanney had agreed to serve as acting secretary for this meeting.

A motion was made by Schaible with support from Little to adopt the agenda as presented. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Little with support from Schaible to dispense with the reading of the March 3, 2015 regular meeting minutes and approve the minutes as presented.

Communications: Chairman Lindemann noted receipt of the March and April editions of the MTA magazine, a MTA continuing education flyer, and a letter requesting transfer of the extraction permit for the Barrett Industries pit to Stoneco as part of an ownership change.

Audience Participation: The Supervisor commented on the status of existing gravel pits in the Township, and activity associated with the E.T. Rover pipeline project. The Zoning Administrator commented on ordinance enforcement activity. No other audience was present.

Old Business: Master plan update. Planner Rodney Nanney summarized the changes in the latest draft. The commissioners reviewed the revised draft sections of the plan. Additional changes were identified. Mr. Nanney will prepare a complete updated plan document for further review.

New Business: Chairman Lindemann noted that the regular May meeting date conflicts with a special election, and confirmed with the commissioners a special meeting date of Thursday, May 7, 2015 at 7:30 p.m. Chairman Lindemann agreed to post the change in the schedule.

Reports: The Supervisor reported on Wireless Washtenaw activities in Lima Township.

Audience Participation: None.

Items on next month's agenda are the Master Plan update and Stoneco's request for transfer of Barrett Industries' existing extraction permit.

A motion was made by Schaible with support from Ochs to adjourn the meeting. Motion passed. The meeting was adjourned at 9:45 p.m.
